Dr. Hananel Holzer is currently the Director of two leading IVF centers in Israel. Dr. Holzer is the Former Medical Director of the McGill University Health Centre Reproductive Centre and the Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility Division of McGill University. He is also involved in developing fertility related projects around the world mainly in Central Europe.

Dr. Holzer graduated from the Hebrew University and Hadassah Medical School as a Valedictorian in 1992, completed his Ob. Gyn. Residency at Hadassah and continued working at the University Hospital as the Deputy Director of the IVF unit. He was also the founder and director of the fertility clinic and a Woman's Health Centre in the city of Modi'in. Dr. Holzer completed a two year REI Fellowship Program at McGill University in Montreal where he was later recruited as a staff member. Between 2008 and 2012, Dr. Holzer served as the Director of the REI Fellowship Program at McGill University. In 2010 he was appointed as the Medical Director of the McGill University Health Centre Reproductive Centre and later as the Director of the Reproductive Endocrinology and Infertility Division. He led the center through its rapid growth and development. He served as a member of many committees among which are the provincial ART advisory committees in Quebec and Ontario. He is currently serving the Chair of the Overseeing Committee of the Israeli National ART Registry, member of the Ministry of Health IVF Standards Advisory Committee and several other advisory boards. Dr. Holzer is the author of many publications in the field of infertility, a member of editorial boards of several journals and is a highly regarded invited speaker around the world.

His main interests are fertility preservation for cancer patients, in-vitro maturation of oocytes and a comprehensive team approach to infertility related issues.
