Professor Neri Laufer, is a pioneer in the field of reproductive biology, specializing in infertility (IVF, in vitro fertilization). He was the co-founder of IVF centers in Yale, New Haven, CT and Mt. Sinai Hospital, NY and of both Hadassah IVF centers, Ein Karem and Mt. Scopus. Among his achievements is that he was the first to publish successful artificial preparation of the endometrium and oocyte donation in women without ovaries.

Professor Laufer is past chairman of the Israel Fertility Society and a past member of the advisory board of ESHRE (European Society of Human Reproduction and Embryology). He served on the editorial board of *Fertility Sterility* and is an associate editor for both *The Journal of Assisted Reproduction and Genetics* and of *Reproductive Sciences*. He is a the author of over 260 papers and chapters in books
